ELHS is on a 4/4 block. There are four 90 min. classes each day, with the new semester beginning late January. Seniors are only required to take the number of credits they need to graduate. ELHS does not limit the number of courses taken.. Our CCP enrollment through Gaston College is open to 11/12 graders.
