*A 3 ch *Global Diversity & Domestic Diversity* course is required and can be taken as other general education courses or electives. Additionally 12 credit hours of *Writing Intensive* courses must be completed which include ENGL 1100, ENGL 2201, a major writing intensive course and an additional WI course of the student's choice. The student's choice WI can also be completed with general education courses or other electives.

^ Students can substitute **BIOL 2130/2131** with the **BIOL 2140/2141 and BIOL 2150/2151** sequence (both courses must be completed to receive credit). Additionally, students wishing to substitute the sequence for BIOL 2130/2131 must also take an additional general education science to fulfill requirements for graduation.

Students wishing to pursue an **Occupational Therapy graduate level program post graduation should consider the following: Must take BIOL 2140/2141 and BIOL 2150/2151 in place of BIOL 2130/2131. Should use the following courses as electives: CHEM 1120 (prerequisite for BIOL 2140/2141), SOCI 2110 or ANTH 1000, ATEP 2800 or HIMA 3000, MATH 2228 - Statistics, and OCCT 3000. All are requirements for ECU's Occupational Therapy program and grade of B- or higher is required in all classes for OT program.

***RT Restricted Electives: RCTX 4210/4211, RCTX 5000, RCTX 5001, RCTX 4100/6100, RCTX 4252, RCTX 4004/6004, RCTX 4200, RCSC 2400, RCSC 3003, or other courses approved by advisor and Program Director
