**NOTES:**

*12 s.h. of Writing Intensive (WI) courses must be completed, typically including ENGL 1100, ENGL 2201; at least 3 s.h. in the major and an additional WI of the student's choice.*

*A 3 s.h. Global Diversity course and a 3 s.h. Domestic Diversity course are also required (these can coincide with other general education or major courses)*

*^MATH 1050 is accepted for French. However, if you plan to pursue the Education concentration, you will need MATH 1065 or 1066 or 2127 instead*

*\*FREN 2004 is a prerequisite for all FREN courses. Many of our majors are double majors. Students should meet with their French advisor as soon as possible to discuss their course plan*

*\*\*French majors are required to take one GLST course (3 s.h.) as part of their general education requirements.*

*\*\*\* In addition to FREN 3001, 3222, 3550, French majors are required to complete 21 hours of 3000/4000 FREN electives. At least 9 of those hours must be at the 4000-level.*
