^ 4 Writing Intensive (WI) courses must be completed, typically including ENGL 1100, ENGL 2201; at least 3 semester hours (s.h.) in the major and an additional WI of the student's choice.

Student MUST take 6 Criminal Justice (CRIM) Electives above 2999 (18 s.h.). Up to 9 s.h. of field experience courses are allowed (4330, 4660, 4990).

A 9 credit hour internship (CRIM 4990) is not required but still strongly encouraged!

Student MUST take 2 Criminology Courses (6 semester hours) from this list: CRIM 3003, 3400, 3525, 3605, 4005, 4615, 4620, or 4625.

Student MUST take 2 Justice Systems Courses (6 semester hours) from this list: CRIM 2009, 2012, 3112, 3200, 3620, 4006, or 4300.

As a Forensic Science Minor, you MUST take CRIM 1000, 3007, 3020, 3022, and 3023. Your Forensic Science Minor Electives will be ANTH 2015, 2016 or BIOL 2015, 2016 so it can satisfy your General Education: Science with Lab as well. ART 1250 sastifies your General Education: Fine Arts, too. The other 4 s.h. minor elective(s) can from this list: ANTH 3026 (3) or BIOL 2130 (4) or CHEM 1020 (4) or 1120 (3) or 1150, 1151 (3, 1) if you have completed their prerequisites. ANTH 3026 or BIOL 2130 is the best ones to enrolled in because this plan has their prerequisites planned out for you.

A 3 s.h. Global Diversity (GD) course and a 3 s.h. Domestic Diversity (DD) course are also required (these can coincide with other general education or major courses). If you take ANTH 2015 or BIOL 2015 for the Forensic Science Minor, that will satisfy your GD requirement. SOCI 2110 is a required Social Science for all CJ majors so that will satisfy your DD requirement, too.

Criminal Justice majors and minors must pass all required criminal justice courses with a minimum grade of "C" (2.0).
