*Select ENGL 2201 (WI) section labeled "Social Sciences" or "Multidisciplines."

^ 4 Writing Intensive (WI) courses must be completed, typically including ENGL 1100, ENGL 2201; at least 3 semester hour [s.h.] within your primary major (CRIM) and your remaining Writing Intensive (WI) will be CHEM labs required for your secondary major, Chemistry.

Student MUST take 6 Criminal Justice (CRIM) Electives above 2999 (18 s.h.). Only 9 s.h. of field experience courses are allowed (4330, 4660, 4990). **Completing at least one field experience (internship) is optional BUT STILL STRONGLY ENCOURAGED!**

Student MUST take 2 Criminology Courses (6 s.h.) from this list: CRIM 3003 or 3400 or 3525 or 3605 or 4005 or 4615 or 4620 or 4625.

Student MUST take 2 Justice Systems Courses (6 s.h.) from this list: CRIM 2009 or 2012 or 3112 or 3200 or 3503 or 3620 or 4006 or 4300.

As a Forensic Science Minor, you MUST take CRIM 1000, 3007, 3020, 3022, and 3023. Your Forensic Science Minor Electives will be ANTH 2015, 2016 or BIOL 2015, 2016 so it can satisfy your General Education: Science with Lab. ART 1250 satisfies your General Education: Fine Arts, too. The other 4 s.h. minor electives can from this list: ANTH 3026 (3) or BIOL 2130 (4) or CHEM 1020 (4) or 1120 (3) or 1150, 1151 (3, 1) if you have completed their prerequisites.

As a Forensic Science Minor, your 3 s.h. Global Diversity (GD) course is ANTH 2015 or BIOL 2015, and your 3 s.h. Domestic Diversity (DD) course is SOCI 2110.

Criminal Justice majors and minors must pass all required criminal justice courses with a minimum grade of "C" (2.0).
